

Trash and waste

A trash room is located at the beginning of the walkway, on the left when exiting the elevator. However, it is recommended to use the large outdoor bins located by the roadside outside the building.

Selective sorting is in place for cardboard, glass, and household waste.



Ski locker Access

Each apartment has a ski locker located on level -1. To access it from the apartments, take the elevator to level -1. The door to the locker room opens with the same key as your locker, which is numbered the same as your apartment.

From the **entrance hall**, you can also take the **staircase** down.

If you are outside, there is a door at the bottom of the slope, on the right side of the building. This door must be used when wearing ski boots. 🥬 You can also access the ski area from this door via the ski locker room.

Ski-in Access

To return from your ski session, you can access the building ski-in. Simply follow the signs for "Club Med." You will pass above the summer toboggan run, then through a tunnel that leads to the Club Med forecourt. Continue straight for about 100 meters, then turn left and follow the trail.

When the trail curves to the right and the slope steepens, you will see our building on the right. Go around it on the left and take the narrow passage. This will bring you directly to the ski locker room door. 🥬

Resort

Situated between the **Northern and Southern Alps** on a beautiful plateau at 1,800 meters above sea level, **Alpe d'Huez** offers access to 250 km of ski slopes. It is also one of the sunniest resorts in the French Alps. Its slopes are connected to those of **Oz, Vaujany**, and **Auris-en-Oisans**.

Famous as one of the iconic spots of the **Tour de France**, Alpe d'Huez boasts a packed events calendar year-round, both in winter and summer. The resort is also home to France's longest ski run: the **Sarenne**, with a 2,000-meter vertical drop over 16 km. 🛆 🔊
